There is one room on the Second Floor for adults or young people capable of using a ladder fire escape. This doubles as a staff guest room. So you need to establish, by contacting your duty manager, whether or not this is available before allocating it. If it is not available, there is usually a twin room available elsewhere on site.

**NOTES**

All rooms have washbasins

S1 has a Lobby containing the only 2'6" bunk / bed at Quinta.

The door between the lobby can be shut but it leaves the lobby airless – no windows.

S1 and its lobby is therefore suitable for a couple with two children or 4 adults, two of whom can cope with the small bunk.

There are six en-suites: S1, W8, W9 and W10. G1 and G2 are suitable for people with disabilities. We do not charge a premium for en suites. If you want to subsidise some people, why not charge more for those using the en-suites.

Children 2yrs and under who are also in a cot are free.

**ANALYSIS**

38 rooms; 67 single beds, 11 double beds, 26 spaces on 13 bunks: giving 104 spaces for single people but 115 spaces if couples use double beds and families can fill every space.

Treating double beds as single spaces the room sizes are: 4 singles, 15 twin, 9 three bed, 7 four bed and 3 five bed.

Treating double beds as double spaces the room sizes are: 3 singles, 13 double or twin, 6 three bed, 12 four bed and 4 five bed.
