



In need of a break this summer - why not book to holiday at Quinta?!

Due to the coronavirus pandemic, none of our usual summer camps, holidays and conferences are able to take place this year. But, from 4th July, restrictions have been eased sufficiently to allow us to go on holiday again. We have all our accommodation units lying empty and we have plenty of outdoor space. So we have decided to offer you a unique, once in a lifetime opportunity of coming to Quinta for your family summer holiday. Read on to see what the options are and how you can book for that special time away.



Option 1: Indoor self-catered accommodation

We have five different, fully self-contained, family-sized or bigger, accommodation units that are available to book from 6th July, with on-going availability into September or October. Each unit has its own fully equipped kitchen, dining room and lounge; as well as at least 10 bed spaces, mainly single beds.



Perry Lodge (above left) and Dyfrdwy House (above right) are individual properties each with their own private garden with fire pit, and plenty of parking right outside.

The Archway (below left), The Annexe (below centre) and Severn Lodge (below right) are part of the same complex at the top of the site, but all are independent. There is plenty of parking outside. Severn Lodge and The Annexe include a games area.



Option 2: Bring your own caravan


We have 20 pitches available. Five of these are on the Caravan Club CL site and fifteen are on the main field below Quinta Hall, which is available for anyone. All these pitches are grass pitches and come with electric hook-up. All caravans must have their own toilet and shower facilities as the on-site facilities will **not** be available.



What can you do whilst at Quinta?

On-site – walk around the lake, fish, play Frisbee golf, follow the tree trail, photo treasure hunt, plenty of space for ball games, tennis courts, have a campfire. From July 15th we hope to open a café for morning coffee, light lunches and afternoon teas.

Off-site – the local area is packed with places to go and explore. Walk along the canals and over the aqueducts; head to the hills for more strenuous walks; there are four National Trust properties within 40 minutes; Chester and Shrewsbury are just over half an hour away; the beaches of North Wales are within an hour's drive; Chester Zoo is 40 minutes away and is one of the country's finest. You will be able to fill your time quite easily!



How much will it cost?

The indoor accommodation is available for a minimum 4 night stay, although you are of course welcome to stay longer.

Perry Lodge and Dyfrdwy House - £500 for the first 4 nights; £100 a night thereafter.

Severn Lodge, Annexe and Archway - £400 for the first 4 nights; £75 a night thereafter.

These prices are for a family or household of up to 6 people. If you bring more people/households then we would ask you please to make a suitable donation on top of the above prices.

We will provide bed-linen for you if you book the indoor accommodation, but will leave you to make up your beds. We will ask you to strip the bedding at the end of your stay. We also ask that properties are cleaned before you leave and are left as you found them. Please bring your own towels. Sorry – no pets!

Caravan pitch - £17 per caravan per night, includes electric hook-up.
